Q: I feel healthy, why should I get tested?	Q: Do I need to see a Doctor to be tested?	Q: Do I need an appointment?
A: A serious medical condition such as heart disease, prostate cancer, or diabetes can exist without noticeable symptoms for up to two years. Early detection is your best defense. A simple blood test can indicate what is happening to assist you in reversal of potential problem areas, and establish a baseline of your normal ranges for which future tests can be monitored.	A: Consumers are realizing that they need to take control of their own health, and direct-to-consumer access for LAB testing programs allow greater participation in one's own healthcare. Physicians refer to USB for this reason, and because you are referred to the same labs that physicians and hospitals use, which are certified and regulated by the appropriate governmental agencies.	A: An appointment is usually not required at most Patient Service Centers. The requisition form we either fill out or send to you will indicate if it is necessary. But remember, fasting is recommended for many tests.
Q: When will I receive the results?	Q: Are the results confidential?	Q: Will I be able to understand the results?
A: You can expect to receive the results by first class mail within three to five days after your blood is drawn. Results are also available online within 48-72 hours. The process is totally secure and confidential.	A: Absolutely. You are the only one who receives the LAB results unless you specifically direct us otherwise. Not even your insurance company will obtain results from USB and/or associates..	A: Yes. All test results include the normal reference ranges, and abnormalities indicated. We recommend you seek a doctor to discuss results out side normal ranges.

A: We use the leading national laboratories, which are fully accredited, licensed Medical Reference Labs. These are the same labs your physician uses. A: Questions regarding abnormal results should be discussed with your Doctor. You may call or write with any general questions regarding your results

Medicare patients must have a Doctor's order by a Physician with a Medicare number, and the diagnostic code accepted by Medicare.	A: Certified laboratories have Patient Service Centers throughout the United States where patients have their blood drawn. These are the same facilities referred to by Doctors.

A: USB uses all major certified Medical Reference Laboratories throughout the United States with Patient Service Centers close to where you live or work. Special arrangements can be made for an area without a facility.	A: You may order by phone, fax or online. We then refer you to the laboratory with the Patient Service Center most convenient to your home or office, where the blood is drawn by a certified phlebotomist. The results print in our office within 48 hours and mailed confidentially to you.	A: You may complete a secure online order form which is emailed in encrypted code. To protect you and your credit card information, we use Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) technology, which is the industry standard and among the best software available today for secure commerce transactions.
